

Bald Eagle Craft

Check out this simple Bald Eagle craft! Kids will love making it. It's a great craft for American patriotic holidays OR leave off the stars and just have fun making this majestic bird with your crew of kids. Make this eagle while reading the book [National Parks of the USA by Kate Siber](#).



Materials

- Eagle Template (below)
- construction paper, colored copy paper, or colored cardstock
- scissors
- stapler
- glue sticks
- marker (for eyes)

Print the Template and Cut Out the Eagle Shapes



Once you have the template printed, separate the pages based on the final craft colors. Then, staple each template to multiple sheets of construction paper and cut out all of the shapes you need

How to Assemble



I recommend having a completed eagle so the children can see what the final version will look like.

1. Glue the tail behind the body.
2. Glue the head onto the top of the body.
3. Glue the wings onto the back of the body.
4. Glue on the beak.
5. Optional: glue on the stars.
6. Draw on the eyes.
7. Don't forget to write your name on the back.

And you're finished!

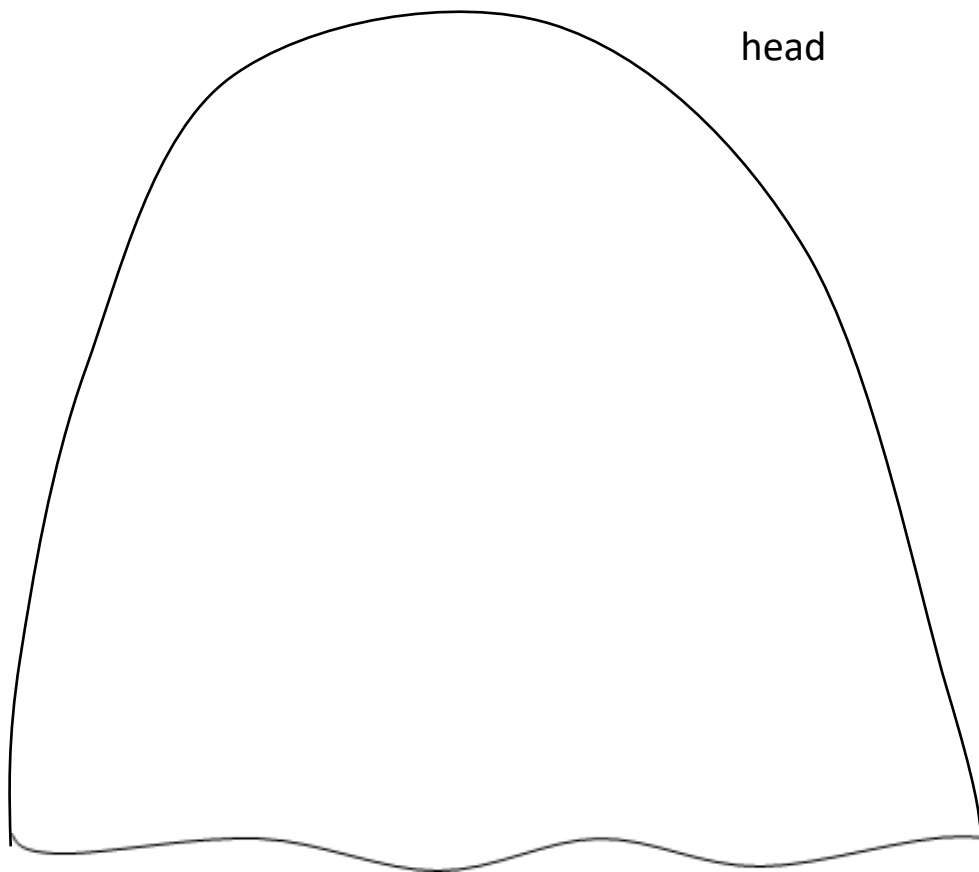
Print and staple to multiple sheets of brown paper. Then cut.

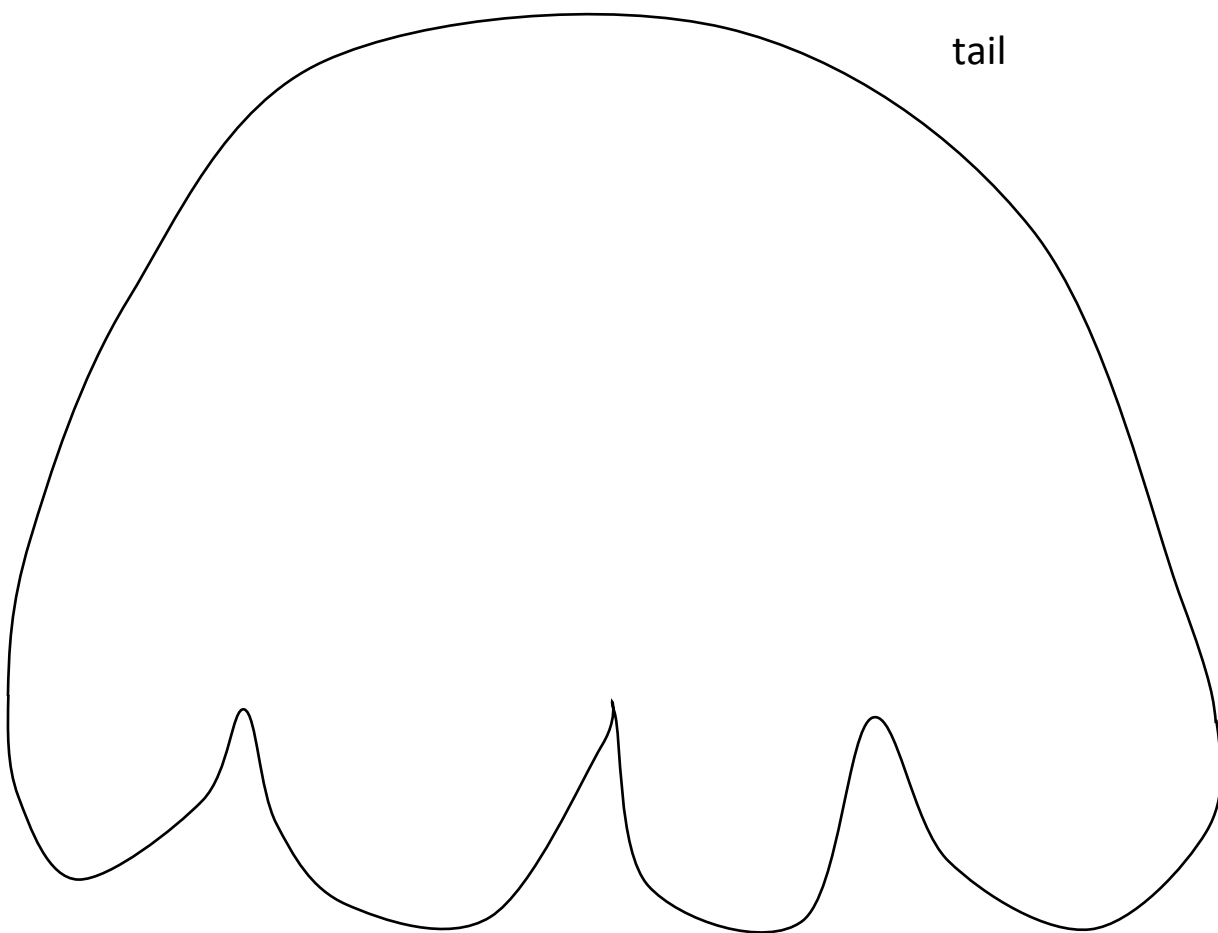


Print and

head

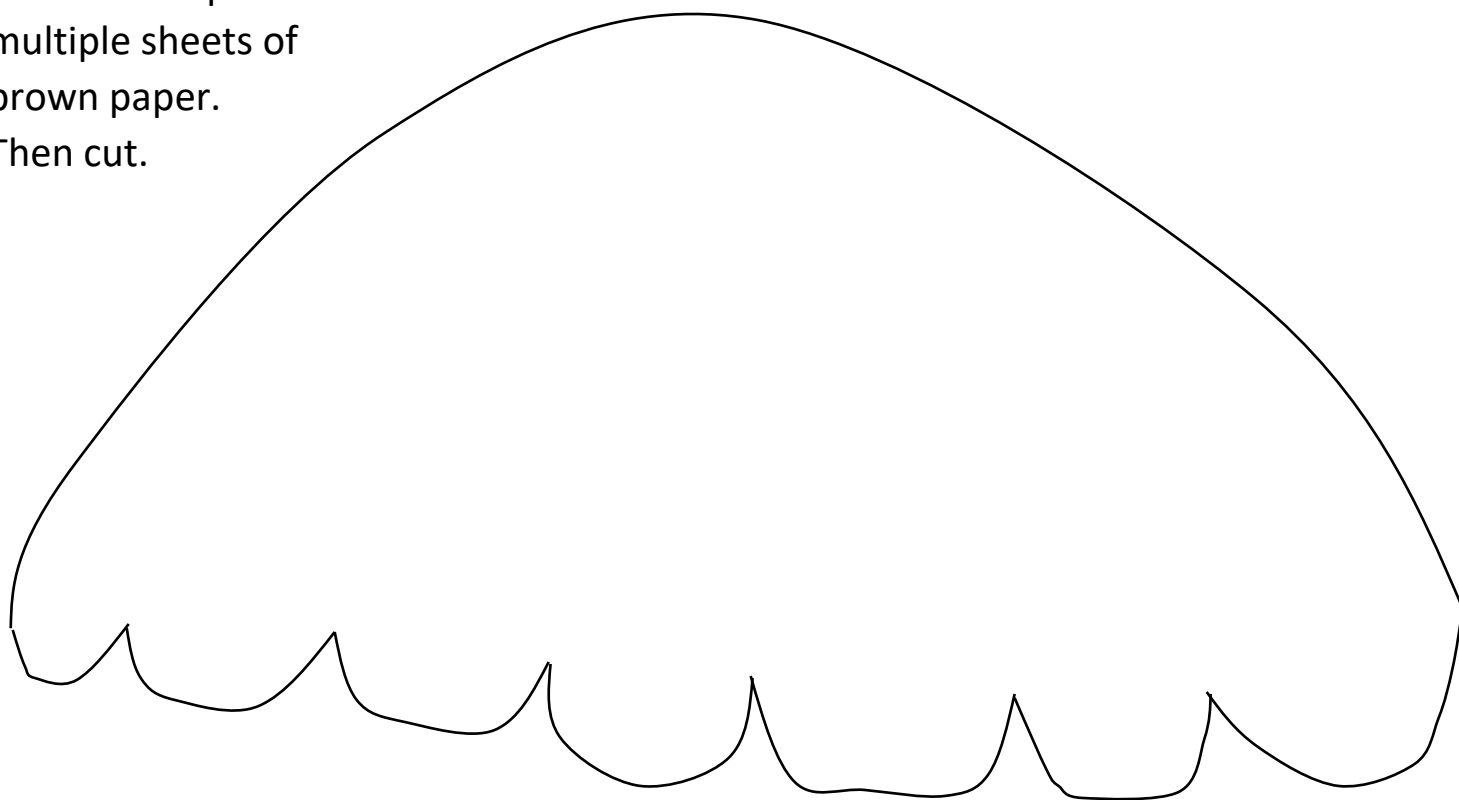


tail

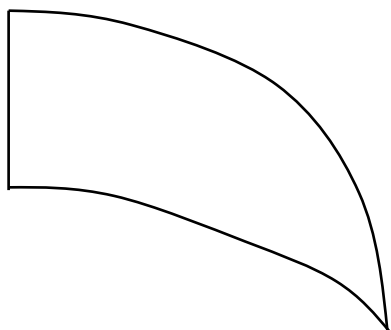


Print and staple to
