

# Heart American Flag Craft

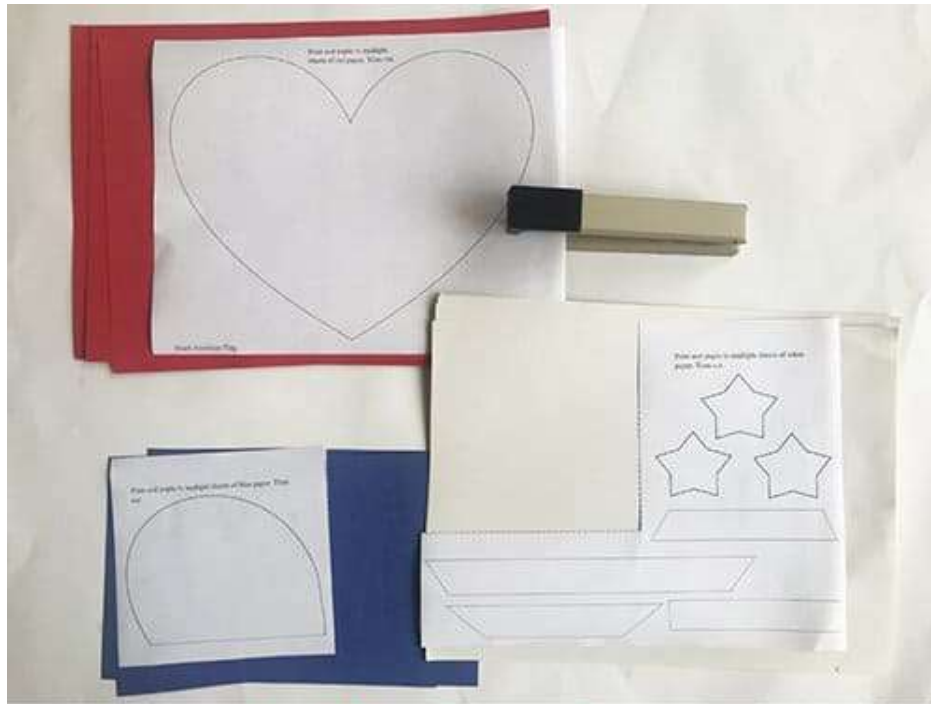
Show your love for the U.S.A. with this adorable heart flag! This craft is like a fun patriotic puzzle for kids to make. It's perfect for any of the American holidays. Make this craft while reading the book [What Does It Mean To be American? by Rana DiOrio](#)



## Materials

- Flag Heart Template (below)
- colored copy paper, colored cardstock, or construction paper
- scissors (good pair)
- stapler
- glue sticks

## Print the Template and Cut Out the Craft Shapes



Once you have the template printed, separate the pages based on the final craft color. Then, staple each template to multiple sheets of construction paper and cut out all of the shapes you need.

### **For each flag you will need:**

- 1 red heart
- 1 blue semi-circle
- 3 white stars
- 4 white stripes



The white strips from the template a little longer than the heart. This way they are easy to glue to the heart and can be trimmed when the heart is completed.

# How to Assemble

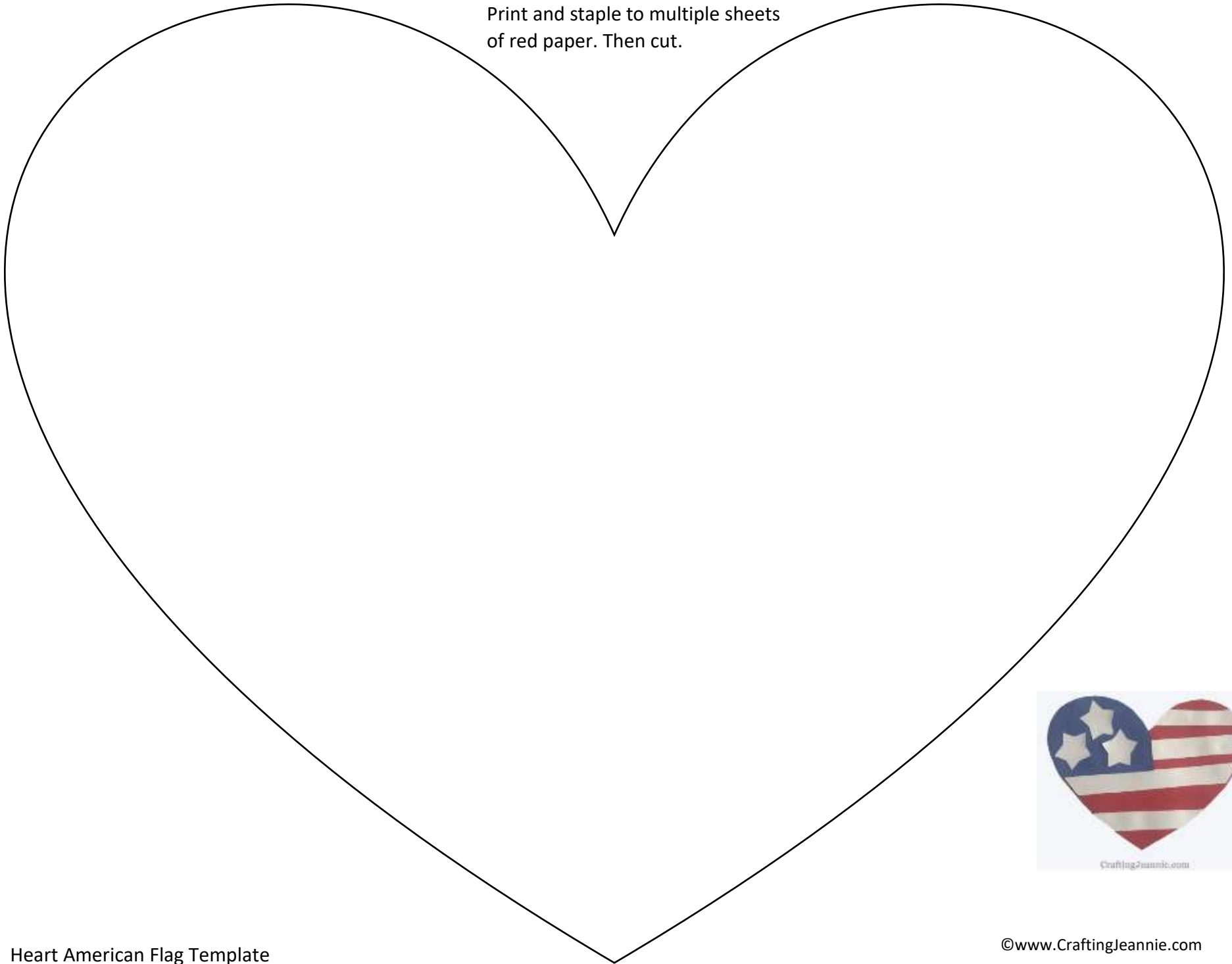


**I recommend having a flag that is already put together so the children can see what the final version will look like.**

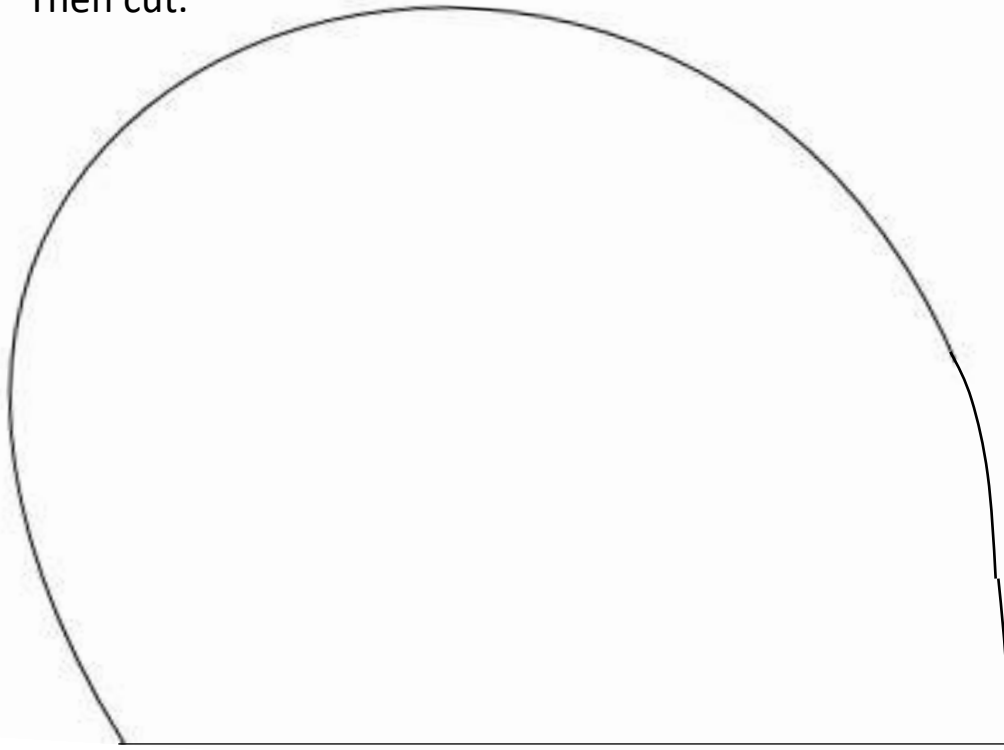
1. Start with the red heart.
2. Glue the blue semi-circle to the top left portion of the heart.
3. Glue the white stars onto the blue semi-circle.
4. Glue on the white stripes (this can be a little tricky, rotate the stripes until they fit best).
5. Don't forget to write your name on the back.

**And you're finished!**

Print and staple to multiple sheets  
of red paper. Then cut.



Print and staple to multiple sheets of blue paper.  
Then cut.



Print and staple to multiple sheets of  
white paper. Then cut.
