

# Ocean Activity Packet

Start by printing out as many copies as you need for your event. You can use the print-out activities like a coloring page and a word search to keep children busy while you set up crafts and games. If you have enough help, you may want to have stations at your event. You can set-up different areas for each activity and the children can rotate. You can even assign an activity from this packet to each volunteer and spread out the responsibilities.

If you're hosting your event by yourself, Do Not Fear - everything in the packet can be done with a group of kids lead by one adult. The crafts are easy to prepare and simple to make, the bingo game includes 30 unique bingo cards. Madlibs will get all of the children laughing, and the games will get the kids moving.

**Most of the activities require crayons or markers. The crafts require glue sticks and a black crayon or marker.**

Use these ideas as rotating game stations or as group activities.

### A Word Search


Kids will enjoy a themed word search, they can find all the words or just find five words, use it however you need it.

Cut the pages in half and enjoy a fun game of bingo. Play traditional (horizontal, vertical, or diagonal line wins) or if you need a longer game, play to fill entire cards. No need to bring bingo covers, just use a marker or crayon to mark each called box with an "X".


**Games 1-2: Feed the Shark.** Two games in one! Print the Feed the Shark template (found on the next page) on cardstock. Game 1: cut out the black of the shark's mouth and tape the shark to a bucket or bowl. Then have the children throw items into the shark's mouth. You can use beanbags, ping-pong balls, plastic fish, or even coins. Separate the children into teams or have them just take turns. Maybe they each have to get three in; you make the rules! Game 2: Play the game similar to Pin the Tail on the Donkey. Tape the shark printout to the wall. Print and cut out the bingo calling cards found in this packet. Give each child an animal square with tape attached. The children take turns being blindfolded and spun. Then they can try to feed the shark their animal.

**Game 3: Fishing.** Cut out fish from construction paper (or use the calling cards from the bingo game in this packet). You can write different actions on the back of each animal. Example things to write: "Do 10 jumping jacks", "Run in place for 5 seconds", "Sing the alphabet", "Pretend you are swimming", "Hop like a frog while saying ribbit", "Make your friend do something again", "Dab", "Act like a chicken", "Yell out your favorite candy", "Say your favorite color", "Pretend you're playing a sport", "Give yourself a high-five". Attach paper clips to each animal. Place the fish on the ground with the picture/blank side facing upwards and the kids all get a turn to "fish" with a pole (that you make from a stick, string and magnet on the end of the string). They all have to act out whatever is on the fish they catch.

**Game 4: Ocean Relay.** Divide the players into two teams. Put a bin/basket for each team across the room. The children will be in two lines, each child must complete a mini obstacle course from one side of the room and back. On the way there, they must "catch" (pick up) an ocean animal and place it in the bin, then come back and the next child will go. The first team to get all of their animals in the bin wins. You will need a printout of an animal for each child in each team (you can use the printouts from the bingo calling cards found in this packet - or use toy animals if you have them - It is ok to have more than one of the same animal). Here are a few obstacle course ideas: tape a line on the floor that they must balance on, a hoop they must pick up and put over their head and down to their feet before they keep going, the adult leader can hold a broom they must crawl under, use bowls from the Dollar store upside-down as "rocks" they must step on, have a toy tunnel or large cardboard box they must crawl through.


**Game 5: Don't Get Stuck With The Shark.** This game is an animal version of hot potato. Use a plastic shark or any ocean animal. You will need the ability to play music (a radio or your phone). Have the children sit/stand in a circle. When the music starts have them pass the shark. When the music stops, the person holding the shark is out. Play until there is one player remaining. If you are in charge of the music, turn your back as they play so you are being fair about stopping the music. There are Hot Potato videos on youtube that randomly start and stop music and there are Hot Potato timer apps that you can also use.

**Game 6: Cup Stack.** Kids LOVE stacking cups to see how high they can build a tower. I always bring about 100 plastic cups (recyclable) to any party. Challenge the players to see who can build the tallest, and then ask who can build the fastest. If needed, this simple game can usually be unsupervised in the corner of a room.
